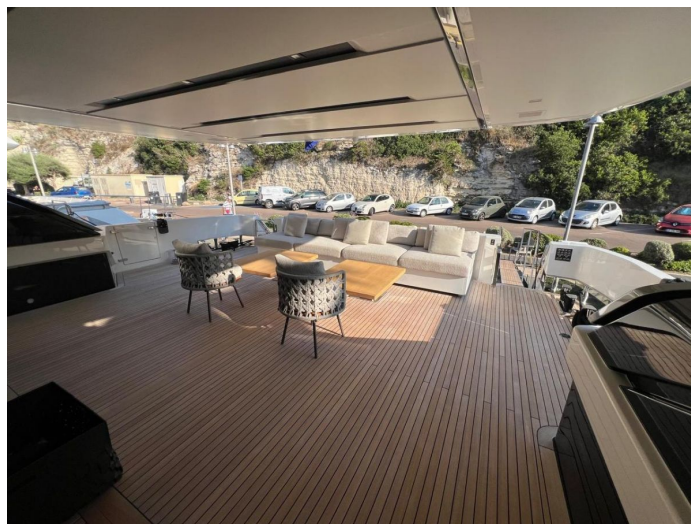
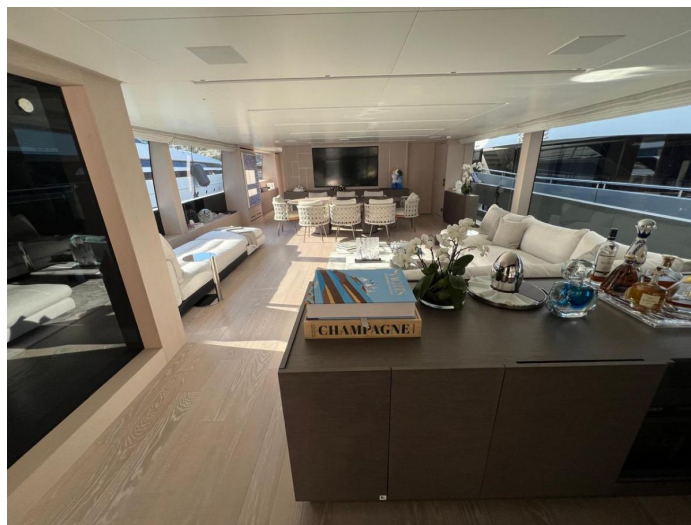
#### BROKERS COMMENTS:
